The safety and well-being of our Residents is of primary importance each and every day. In light of the COVID-19 outbreak, and our "at-risk" population, the Little Sisters of the Poor continue to adhere to all governmental recommendations and regulations while also initiating additional precautions.

From this week's round of testing, we have all the test results back and we are thankful to the Lord that we have no new cases to report. The employee who tested positive last week remains self-quarantined at home, then will be retested before being allowed to return to work.

We remain on guard for the protection of all, and we see that even though the numbers are down in Maryland, the virus still spreads, and the threat still exists. Because of this, we are delaying our in-person visits and the popular window visits will be conducted with stringent safety measures. There are outdoor chairs available for your comfort, but the windows need to remain closed while you talk with your loved one on the phone. We know that you understand these concerns as we follow the guidelines so that we can continue the safety and well-being of those entrusted to our care.
