The Little Sisters of the Poor have ministered to the needy elderly of Baltimore since 1869. Our first home opened on Calvert Street, and then a permanent home was built on Valley Street, not far from Johns Hopkins Medical Center. We stayed there for 100 years, until the building became obsolete.

In 1969 we moved from our home in Baltimore City to our current location in Catonsville. We knew the new St. Martin's would serve us and our Residents well. And it has for 50 years. Since 2010 St. Martin's has been undergoing extensive renovation and reconstruction.

Even while this important work has progressed, we have continued to care for over 65 needy elderly persons, welcoming them as we would Christ himself and caring for them as members of our own family.

The proceeds from our Nun Run will contribute to our general operating budget so that we may continue to make the elderly happy as we build a tomorrow of love and hope for our eldest brothers and sisters at St. Martin's Home.

are an international congregation of Roman Catholic women religious founded in 1839 by Saint Jeanne Jugan. Together with a diverse network of collaborators, we serve the elderly poor in over 30 countries around the world.
