To: All family members of a current St. Martin Resident and to our friends,

I thankfully write you today to share that after our second round of testing this week, we have no further positive cases of COVID-19 in our Home. However, because of the positive test result on Monday, May 3, we are still considered to be in outbreak status and will resume testing bi-weekly next week as well. Although we may not be back to where we were pre-COVID, progress is being made and recovery is on the horizon.

The health and safety of your loved one remains our top priority. Because of this, St. Martin's Home and the Little Sisters of the Poor continue to practice strict guidelines concerning hygiene, social distancing, and infection control while abiding by all CDC, Department of Health, Governor Hogan's office, and CMS guidance as it pertains to containing and managing the COVID-19 virus. I will continue sending you weekly letters, but any updates during the week if there is a change in our COVID status, will be sent to you within 72 hours and posted to our website.

This Sunday is Mothers' Day, and we encourage you to window visit with your loved one here. Although we plan a nice Mass and dinner for all our Residents, they especially want to see you. Please check in with Danielle, our Activity Director to see what type of visit is possible this weekend. If you are unable to visit, please remember to spend time with them through telephone calls, Zoom, Skype, or FaceTime.

We look forward to the day when restrictions are lifted but at this time, we can only ask for your patience and understanding as we comply with the government's requirements for protecting the health and safety of our all those we care for.

We assure you of our prayers and we pray for all our mothers, both living and deceased, for this beautiful gift of life they have given us.
