Again this week I am pleased to report that we have negative results from our in-house testing of all unvaccinated Residents and employees. Although this is a strong indication that the pandemic is entering a recovery phase, we want to assure you that St. Martin's is being proactive when it comes to COVID-19 and keeping our beloved Residents safe and healthy.

As you know, family and friends are an invaluable part of our Residents' lives and there is nothing that can replace visiting a loved one in person. Whether it's your regular day to visit or a special day such as the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly on July 25, our Activities Director, Danielle, will be happy to make the arrangements for you. Once you arrive, you will need to complete a screening for COVID-19 symptoms or exposure along with a temperature check. We do ask when you socialize to follow CDC guidelines — observe social distancing, perform hand hygiene frequently, and wear your mask over your nose and mouth.

Since the start of the pandemic, we have been on the front line implementing all the guidance from the CDC (Centers for Disease Control), CMS (Centers for Medicare/Medicaid Services), the Department of Health and Governor Hogan's office. St. Martin's has always had policies and procedures designed to help reduce the risk of illnesses being spread from person to person, and we have long followed infection control protocols provided by the CDC to help protect against the spread of infectious illnesses.
