I am once again so grateful to inform our family members and friends that all testing done this week of unvaccinated employees was negative. And additionally we remain diligent in our quest to encourage those same employees to take advantage of the vaccine.

We want to assure you that St. Martin's is being proactive when it comes to COVID-19 and keeping Residents and employees safe and healthy. Since the start of the pandemic, St. Martin's has been on the front line implementing all the guidance from the CDC, CMS, and the Department of Health.

Governor Hogan assures us that Maryland is one of the most vaccinated states in the country, having the 4th lowest case rate and the 4th lowest positivity rate in the nation. However, that does not mean we are lowering our guard. To maximize protection from the Delta variant and prevent possibly spreading it to others, we continue to wear masks and ask that you remain vigilant as well when you visit your loved one at St. Martin's Home.
