Keeping our Residents safe, healthy, and happy are the main goals of the Little Sisters and the staff of St. Martin's Home. Again this week I am very pleased to inform you that all unvaccinated employees of our Home tested negative for the coronavirus on both testing days. We continue to thank God and our good St. Joseph for this blessing.

As visitations increase, we have made some changes to the process in order to keep everything running smoothly.

- ✓ Continue to make your visitation appointment through our Activities Department.
- ✓ Please call Monday thru Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. to make your appointment. Calls received in the evening will be returned by noon the following workday.
- ✓ Calls received after noon on Friday will not be returned on the weekend. You will hear from the Activities Department by noon on Monday.
- ✓ You will continue to be screened upon entering and departing St. Martin's lobby. And please remember to wear your mask while in our Home and to use the hand sanitizing units conveniently placed throughout the building.
- ✓ If you are vaccinated, you may visit with your loved one either in their room or in Main Street. If unvaccinated, visits will take place in Main Street. Visits are extended to one hour.

Please note if you are doing an in-room visit, there is a two-visitor limit and we ask you to remain in the room for the duration of your time here. Unvaccinated people, children, or more than two visitors must meet in Main Street. All visitors must remain masked including children over two years of age.

We are delighted to welcome you into our Home and hope you will take advantage of this time with your loved one. You are the person they want to see and the one that puts a smile on their face.

The Little Sisters continue to offer their prayers for your good health.
