To: All family members of a current St. Martin's Resident and to our friends,

I am pleased to announce that COVID testing for this week on all unvaccinated employees of St. Martin's Home was negative. There is also additional information to share with you regarding the unvaccinated.

Effective December 5, 2021, all staff members and volunteers must either be vaccinated or have started the vaccination process. Of course this does not include those who have submitted documentation for health or religious exemption to us. Regardless of vaccination status, guests (including children over the age of 2), need to wear their masks properly and be screened upon arrival in our lobby. As I mentioned in last week's letter, you no longer need to call Activities to make an appointment to see your loved one. Vaccinated visitors may visit in the Resident's room while unvaccinated visitors will meet with your loved one in Main Street.

Together with the Little Sisters and the staff of St. Martin's Home, I hope you have a happy and holy Thanksgiving Day. It is nice to gather once again as a family and enjoy all the holiday traditions we missed last year.

As we are now beginning to look to the holy days of Advent, we ask that you take care of yourself and one another. Do your very best to stay healthy and safe. And remember that the Little Sisters are praying for you to have a happy and healthy Christmas.
