I am very sorry to report that positive cases were detected this week during our scheduled testing. We immediately tested all Residents and employees and will do so twice a week until further notice.

Unfortunately, as the most wonderful time of the year is upon us, we are aware that plans were made to bring your loved one to your home or to visit them at St. Martin's. We are aware of the desire to be together for both you and our beloved Residents, but the risk is once again real and the consequences of outside visits could have a life-changing impact on everyone. Visitation is vitally important to all of us as is safety and vigilance of our most vulnerable Residents. We must do all we can to prevent further spread. At this time, we have been advised by our MDH contact that in person visitation may continue under our current guidelines. Please continue to complete the screening at the front lobby kiosk when you enter and leave. Masks must be worn at all times when in the Home and in your loved one's room. Please continue to perform hand hygiene and social distancing.
