To: All family members of a current St. Martin Resident and to our friends,

Again this week, all unvaccinated employees and those employees who did not receive their booster, tested negative for the coronavirus. For this, we continue to thank God and our good St. Joseph.

As you make your plans this week to visit with your loved one at St. Martin's, please remember the guidelines from the Maryland Department of Health that I shared with you last week:

"All visitors, regardless of vaccination status, shall be asked to provide proof of a negative test obtained within 72 hours of entry into the facility or to agree to be tested on site using a point of care/rapid test. If a visitor refuses the request to provide proof of a negative test or to take a test, the visitor shall wear a face covering and physically distance in accordance with CMS and CDC guidance. Visitors that test positive may not enter the facility."
